Overview

With federal workforce disruptions and policy rollbacks under the Trump administration, many Georgia families—particularly federal employees—are facing layoffs, reduced access to benefits, and uncertainty about their futures. In response, Georgia's Democratic leadership has mobilized to offer targeted support, resources, and investments to ensure that public services remain accessible and that affected workers are not left behind.

Georgia Delegation Highlights

Senator Jon Ossoff

Focus Areas: Healthcare Access, Nursing Education, Rural Infrastructure

- Secured \$7.5 million to expand nursing programs at Central Georgia Technical College and Southern Crescent Technical College.
- Funded emergency healthcare infrastructure in Berrien County and helped open a new hospital in Ringgold.

Senator Raphael Warnock

Focus Areas: Federal Workforce Protection, CDC Advocacy, Veterans Equity

- Condemned the Trump administration's layoffs of CDC employees and secured reinstatements for some.
- Launched a federal workers' support portal with legal guidance and whistleblower protection tools.
